Raymond Tripp is the General Manager of Peninsula Town Center, a 1.1 million square-foot regional mixed use town center co-developed by Mall Properties, Inc. and Steiner & Associates. It is the largest mixed use center in Coliseum Central and one of the largest in Hampton Roads. In addition, he manages two other retail centers in the District—Coliseum Square and Mercury Plaza, which also are owned by Mall Properties.

Mr. Tripp was a member of the original exploratory committee that worked with the City of Hampton to establish the Coliseum Central Business Improvement District. He was the second President of the BID, serving for two years from 1997 through 1999. Currently he serves as President.

He is a native of Greenville, NC and he earned his Bachelor's Degree from East Carolina University and has completed post-graduate classes at the University of Georgia and the University of Michigan. Mr. Tripp has been in the shopping center business for over 28 years.

During the last 17 years Mr. Tripp has managed Coliseum Mall as well as being a strong voice in support of the Business Improvement District. He is an active leader in the Peninsula community, serving on a number of boards, commissions and advisory groups.
