Jean Yokum has dedicated her life and career to the service of others. She's positively impacted the lives of many members at Langley Federal Credit Union, provided leadership within her community and the national Credit Union Movement, and has been a tremendous supporter of the military. Initially employed as a teller in 1953, Jean rose through the ranks to her current position of President/CEO in 1979. Jean also currently serves as Treasurer of the Board of Directors. Since becoming President/CEO, LFCU has grown from three branches and \$76 million in assets to seventeen branches with over \$1.5 billion in assets. The Credit Union currently serves over 170,000 members.

Jean has been highly involved in the Credit Union Movement. Jean has served the Virginia Credit Union League on a state level for many years. She is the League's Legislative Representative and serves on the Governmental Affairs and Regulatory Response Committees. Nationally, Jean is a member of the Credit Union Executives Society and a graduate of the Credit Union National Association (CUNA) Management School. She currently serves on the Board of Directors of the Armed Forces Financial Network and serves as the Air Force Representative for the Defense Credit Union Council (DCUC) Board of Directors. Jean was selected as Professional of the Year by the National Association of Federal Credit Unions (NAFCU). In November 2007, she was inducted into the Credit Union Executives Society Hall of Fame. In addition, Jean was honored as NAFCU CEO of the Year in 2009.

Jean's abilities are well recognized in the local business and military community. She is the immediate past President and now serves as Director Emeritus on the Board of Directors of the Virginia Air and Space Center. She has served as Chairman of the Board of the Better Business Bureau, Peninsula Family Services, Inc., and the Peninsula Retail Merchants Association. Jean also serves on the Board of Directors, Executive Committee and is the Peninsula Representative for the USO of Hampton Roads. Jean was named Langley Air Force Base Honorary Commander for the 1st Comptroller Squadron, 1st Fighter Wing.

She is a charter member and Treasurer of the Langley Civic Leaders Association, formed in 2002.
