Mr. Michael Yaskowsky is currently a senior development manager for the City of Hampton's Department of Economic Development. He has been employed with the City since June, 1996. Mr. Yaskowsky is responsible for managing all economic development efforts for two primary industries in Hampton; Aerospace and Homeland Defense. As the Existing Business Team Leader, he is responsible for strategic development of Hampton's current Existing Business Program assisting hundreds of businesses. He led efforts in 2006 that resulted in the creation/retention of 1600 jobs and \$120 million investment. Recent multi-million dollar expansion projects have included Nextel, Howmet Alcoa and the National Institute of Aerospace. Additionally, he managed the master planning efforts for Hampton Roads Center North, a 400 acre, \$8 million premier office park.
