


Robert S. McKenna

- Served as Liaison Officer and Amphibious Advisor to Belgium-Netherlands Task Group from 1999-2001.
- Commanded the Naval and Marine Corps Reserve Center, West Palm Beach, Florida, from January 1996 until January 1998, and the Naval Operational Support Center, Jacksonville, Florida, from June 2009 until June 2011.
- Retired as a Captain in 2011 and returned, with his family, to make his home in Newport News, VA.
- Since retirement, he has been working as a contractor supporting the US Navy, and for a
 nine-month period as a Department of Veteran Affairs community liaison on the Peninsula,
 working to enhance educational and employment opportunities for transitioning service
