



## DALE DRUMRIGHT

In 1991, Dale began coordinating (what was then called) the NAS Norfolk Air Show. She was the first civilian working with the military to have the title of Air Show Coordinator. In 1999, she left Norfolk behind and began working with, what was then called Langley Air Force Base Community Appreciation Day as a community partner. Her first achievement was changing the name to AirPower over Hampton Roads. Within a year and much assistance from the airmen at Langley, she transformed Langley AFB's 1-day air show into a nationally recognized 3-day event, including an after dark air show. In 2001, AirPower over Hampton Roads won the prestigious Dick Schram Memorial Community Relations Award. In December 2013, Dale received a Special Achievement Award for her work on the International Council of Air Shows' Board of Directors.

Due to sequestration and budget constraints, Langley AFB has not held AirPower over Hampton Roads since 2011. Dale is now focusing her time and energy on Real Estate. She is affiliated with William E Wood and Associates as a real estate agent. However, when AirPower over Hampton Roads returns, she plans to assist Langley once again, but will remain focused on her real estate career, as well.

Dale is one of the original members of the Langley Civic Leaders Association. Currently she is the Vice President of Programs. She is also a member of the Air Force Association, active with the International Council of Air Shows (ICAS), as well as on the Board of Directors of the ICAS Foundation.
